**Opt out**

1. Pursuant to 162(1) of the *Civil Procedure Act*, the date before which group members may opt out of the proceedings be fixed at 1 September 2022.
2. Pursuant to section 175 of the *Civil Procedure Act*, the Opt-out Notice annexed to the affidavit of Sally Gleeson sworn 1 July 2022 be given to group members according to the following procedure:
  - (a) On or before 29 July 2022, the plaintiffs to cause the Notice to be displayed on the website of the plaintiffs' solicitors, <http://www.turnerfreeman.com.au>, and to remain so displayed.
  - (b) On or before 29 July 2022, the plaintiffs to post the abridged Notice on the plaintiffs' solicitors' Facebook page, Instagram account and Twitter account.

- (c) On or before 29 July 2022, the plaintiffs to cause a paid advertisement in terms of the abridged Notice to be advertised for a two week period between Friday 29 July 2022 and Thursday 11 August 2022 (inclusive) on Facebook, Twitter and Instagram, in accordance with paragraph 11 of the affidavit of Sally Gleeson sworn 1 July 2022.
- (d) Pursuant to 58.2 of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules*, the plaintiffs' solicitors to provide the defendants with a list of persons who have filed and served opt out notices by 29 September 2022.

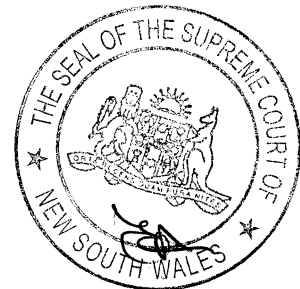

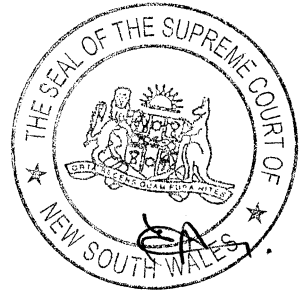

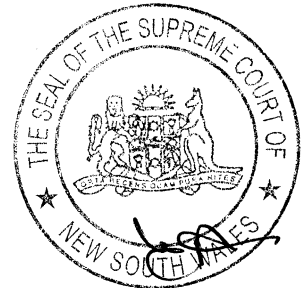
