His Honour Parker J makes the following orders:

1. I make the orders in the Order initialled by me and dated today.

## ORDER

1. Pursuant to sections 173 and 183 of the Civil Procedure Act 2005 (NSW):

(a) the settlement distribution scheme in the form of Confidential Exhibit CPL-1 to the affidavit of Crispian Paul Lynch sworn 3 September 2019 (Settlement Distribution Scheme) be approved; and

(b) Grant Thornton Australia Limited, as Administrator and Contradictor (as defined in the Settlement Distribution Scheme), be authorised to perform the roles and duties specified in the Settlement Distribution Scheme.

2. Until further order of the Court, on the ground that the order is necessary to prevent prejudice to the proper administration of justice, pursuant to section 7 of the Court Suppression and Non-Publication Orders Act 2010 (NSW) and section 183 of the Civil Procedure Act 2005 (NSW) the Confidential Exhibit CPL-1 to the affidavit of Crispian Paul Lynch sworn 3 September 2019 be kept confidential and not be disclosed to any person save for the parties (who, for the avoidance of doubt, do not include the Group Members for this purpose), the Funder, Grant Thornton Australia Limited and their legal representatives, other than by order of a Judge of the Court.

3. Paragraphs 23.1 and 24 of the Notice of Motion filed on 3 April 2019 be dismissed with no order as to costs.

4. Liberty to apply on 3 days' notice.
