

## **GARLING J MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDERS IN PROCEEDINGS 2021/10183:**

1. Pursuant to s 162(1) of the *Civil Procedure Act 2005* (NSW), the date on or before which a Group Member (as defined in the Amended Statement of Claim) may opt out of the proceeding is fixed at 4:00pm (AEDT) on 7 July 2023 (**Class Deadline**).
2. Pursuant to s 176(1) of the *Civil Procedure Act 2005* (NSW), the form and content of the notice in Annexure A (**Notice to Group Members**) be approved.
3. Pursuant to s 183 of the *Civil Procedure Act 2005* (NSW), the notice set out in Annexure B (**Opt Out Notice**) be approved for this proceeding for the purpose of r 58.2(1) of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 2005* (NSW).
4. Pursuant to s 176(2) of the *Civil Procedure Act 2005* (NSW), notice is to be given to group members by no later than 9 June 2023 according to the following procedure:
  - a. The plaintiffs are to display the Notice to Group Members and the Opt Out Notice on the plaintiffs' solicitor's website, [www.apjlaw.com.au](http://www.apjlaw.com.au), continuously until the Class Deadline;
  - b. The plaintiffs are to deliver the Notice to Group Members and the Opt Out Notice to the contact email address where an email is available, or failing that, by ordinary mail, to each group member who is a client of the plaintiffs' solicitors or whom they are otherwise aware.
5. Pursuant to s 162(2) of the *Civil Procedure Act 2005* (NSW) and r 58.2(1) of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 2005* (NSW), any group member who wishes to opt out of this proceeding must, on or before the Class Deadline, deliver an Opt Out Notice to the Registry of the Supreme Court of New South Wales.
6. Stand the matter over until 21 July 2023.
